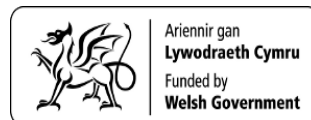

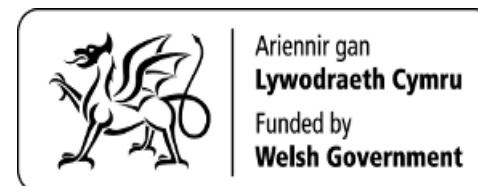
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What you can expect from our Schools Liaison Officers (SLO's):

All SLO's are qualified, experienced teachers with an enhanced DBS. They provide workshops and sessions which raise awareness of Domestic Abuse, Gender Based Violence and Sexual Violence that strongly link to the PSE curriculum.

It is expected that our SLO's will conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times, maintaining confidentiality in relation to both individual pupils and between schools.

Ground Rules

These will be established by the SLO at the start of each session and include the following:

- Show respect for everybody
- Be open minded
- Be safe and responsible about sharing personal information

Delivery

All Spectrum sessions include cross-curricular themes which are linked to the Literacy and Numeracy and PSE Frameworks, the Welsh Bacalaureate and the Welsh Government Sex and Relationship Guidance 2010.

All information discussed with and provided to pupils and teachers will be:

- Delivered sensitively and in a supportive manner
- Accurate and up to date
- Age and ability appropriate
- Lively and interactive
- In a workshop style

Support

Sources of support for young people will be discussed and helpline details will be provided.

Expectations and Guidelines for Schools:

- A teacher must be present in the classroom **at all times** and maintain discipline.
- Foundation Phase sessions operate on a carousel basis and require 2 additional members of staff
- Classroom and other relevant school based staff to be made aware that the issue of abuse will be raised
- Inform the Spectrum team of any pupil with Additional Learning Needs, or of any who may potentially be vulnerable due to the subject matter
- All school staff to attend a Spectrum Staff Training session in order to ensure a whole school response to Domestic Abuse, Violence Against Women and Sexual Violence
- Feedback on and evaluation of the sessions will be requested
